ELK HUNTING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 24.9. – 31.12.2011 IN FINLAND For elk hunting, You will need a rifle that shoots 10 g. bullets at a minimum. Red headgear and a red waistcoat or jacket are compulsory. There are a several methods of hunting. The first method is to wait for the elk at their feeding places in the mornings and evenings – this style is suitable for hunters of all ages as is the second method, which is to lure the elk with sounds that imitate it, which is very interesting and challenging. The most active way of hunting an elk is to use a hunting dog to help You (when the dog finds an elk it barks and this makes the elk freeze in position). This third method really puts Your hunting skills to the test. Average temperature s: October + 5 C, November – 5 C. Each hunter is given the chance to kill one elk. <p>KILLINGFEES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A buck 800 euro + 100 euro/antler spike A female 800 euro, a calf 400 euro
PHEASANT SHOOTING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1.9.2011.-28.02.2012 IN FINLAND A shotgun with 8-5 shot is used for pheasant shooting. Shooting takes place in a special 50-hectare pheasant area where there are fields, and small areas of woodland that provide cover. The dogs used for bird shooting help You by stopping where they find a bird and they make the experience interesting. Pheasant shooting suites hunters of all conditions. You will not necessarily need any special hunting equipment because the Ainola centre is in the middle of the hunting area. Pheasant shooting is extremely suitable as a recreational activity in between business negotiations or as a weekend light-hunting trip. The fee of pheasant shooting includes 2 birds/day and for any further bird, the charge is 50 euro/bird.
CAPERCAILLE, BLACK GROUSE, WILLOW GROUSE, HAZEL GROUSE SHOOTING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 10.9.-31.10. 2011 IN FINLAND A shotgun with 7-3 shot is generally used for this type of shooting. The most common type of bird shooting uses a hunting dog to help (when it finds the bird it stops so that You know where the bird is). We can also go hunting using the client's own dog to help. Bringing an dog in to Finland is easy – just make sure that all vaccinations (rabies, etc..) are in order and remember to bring the vaccination certificates with You. Shooting birds is exciting and sporty. It is the best way of experiencing Lapland's clean nature. A day's trek ranges from 2-10 km depending on the hunter's fitness. Average temperatures: September + 12 c, October + 5 c. During the day, a maximum of 3 birds/hunter can be shot (no shooting fees).
